

Common Business Tax Deductions

- **Home Office Deduction**
If you use part of your home regularly and exclusively for business.
- **Rent / Lease Payments**
Rent for office space, equipment, or storage used for business.
- **Utilities**
Electricity, water, heat, internet, and phone (business portion).
- **Business Insurance**
Premiums for liability, professional, property, or other business-related insurance.
- **Depreciation**
Deduct the cost of big-ticket items (equipment, furniture) over their useful life.
- **Office Supplies**
Paper, pens, postage, printer ink, software subscriptions.
- **Equipment & Furniture**
Computers, desks, phones, and other tangible business assets.
- **Advertising & Marketing**
Website hosting, business cards, social media ads, print ads, promotional materials.
- **Professional Services**
Fees paid to accountants, bookkeepers, attorneys, consultants.
- **Employee Wages & Benefits**
Salaries, bonuses, health insurance, retirement contributions.
- **Contract Labor / Independent Contractors**
Payments to freelancers or subcontractors (reported on 1099-NEC).
- **Business Travel**
Transportation, lodging, and 50% of meals when traveling for business.
- **Business Meals (50%)**
Meals with clients or prospects where business is discussed.

- **Auto Expenses**
Mileage or actual expenses if you use your vehicle for business.
- **Education & Training**
Courses, certifications, webinars directly related to your business.
- **Bank Fees & Interest**
Business credit card interest, loan interest, bank fees.
- **Software & Subscriptions**
Cloud services, apps, bookkeeping software, industry-specific tools.
- **Legal & License Fees**
Business licenses, regulatory fees, permits.
- **Bad Debts**
Debts you can't collect from customers (for accrual-basis businesses).
- **Charitable Contributions (C Corporations)**
Contributions made by C corps to qualified organizations (limitations apply).
